	Genetics	 The applicant must hold a doctorate degree in medicine. Or the applicant must hold both a doctorate degree in medicine and a master's degree in Genetics.
	Microbiology and Immunology	 The applicant must hold a doctorate degree in medicine. Or the applicant must hold both a doctorate degree in medicine and a master's degree in Microbiology and Immunology.

Please note that the university will not accept applications that do not comply with the conditions of this announcement or fail to provide all the required documents, which include:

- 1 Fill the application form on our website.
- 2 Submit high school transcript.
- 3 Submit medical certificate and grade transcript.
- 4 Submit master's degree, and grade transcript, if applicable.
- 5 Equivalency of non-Jordanian certificates.
- 6 Non-criminal certificate.
- 7 Recent personal photo.
- 8 Copy of national ID.

- 9 Copy of the family book.
- 10 Copy of passport.
- Proof of English proficiency test completion (IELTS or TOEFL-IBT)
- 12 Certificate of good conduct from the university of graduation.
- 13 Academic and professional resume accompanied by an experience letter.
- 14 The first page of any published scientific research or an acceptance letter for publication.

Applications will be accepted starting from the date of posting this announcement on the website www.sjifund.com from the 15th of April 2025 until the 30th of May 2025.





Conditions for applying for the scholarship:

- **A-** The applicant must be of Jordanian nationality.
- **B-** The applicant must hold a bachelor's degree from a recognized university, with a grade no less than "Very Good" or a second university degree from a recognized university approved by the committee. If the degree was issued by a non-Jordanian institution, it must be accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research in Jordan.
- **C-** The applicant applying for the scholarship must not exceed the age of 30 for holders of a bachelor's degree, 35 for holders of a master's degree, and 40 for those applying for a partial scholarship.
- **D-** The applicant must have passed an English proficiency test with a score of at least 79 in the TOEFL-IBT exam or a score of at least 6.5 in the IELTS exam. The requirement to pass the language exam is waived for those who have obtained a bachelor's degree or a master's degree from a university in a country where the native language is English. The application for the scholarship may be accepted if the applicant has submitted evidence of registration for the TOEFL-IBT or IELTS exam, provided that the application will not be considered by the college until proof of passing the exam with the required score is provided.
- **E-** The applicant must not have received any disciplinary sanctions during their university studies, except for a warning, which is considered permissible.

Disclosure of Relationship with University and/or SJFMEI Employees: By submitting this application, the applicant certifies that all information provided is true and complete to the best of their knowledge. The applicant must disclose any familial, personal, or professional relationship with any current or former employee, faculty member, administrator, or trustee of the Kingdom University of Health Sciences and/or SJFMEI. Such relationships include, but are not limited to, immediate family members (spouse, parents, siblings, children), close relatives, partners, or any other association that may reasonably be perceived as creating a conflict of interest or undue influence in the scholarship selection process.

Failure to disclose such relationships may result in disqualification from the scholarship, revocation of the award if discovered after disbursement, or other appropriate actions as determined by the Kingdom University of Health Sciences and/or SJFMEI.
